

2019 IAPSS Legislative Priorities

- IAPSS advocates for the increase of Foundational Funding levels to a minimum of 1.5% above the Federal Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for each year of the biennium to support student learning.
- IAPSS advocates for transparent independent appropriation and reporting of taxpayer dollars to fund private, for profit or privately managed charters, and parochial schools.
- IAPSS advocates for increased non-competitive school safety funding for all school corporations with additional flexibility of use and elimination of the matching requirement to support student safety.
- IAPSS advocates for a minimum increase to the school safety grant of \$100,000 for each school corporation or \$50 per student (whichever is greater).
- IAPSS advocates for the inclusion of IAPSS appointed representatives to serve on any state-level educational policy and decision-making group or committee to support student learning.
- IAPSS advocates for creating a public school appointed voting position on local or county boards that have a fiscal impact on public school operations and local control, accountability, autonomy to support student learning.
- IAPSS advocates for creating a public school appointed voting position on a local or county boards, such as but not limited to COIT, Planning Commission, Redevelopment Commission or Zoning Commission.
